Responsibilities:

- Communicate effectively, both oral and written
- Deep knowledge and understanding of the missions and programs of Colorado Youth Outdoors

Hours and Compensation:

Part Time: Vary based on weekly programs and Instructor availability: Core Programs are Tuesdays and Thursdays 4:30pm – 8:30pm Additional hours for summer camps, weekend programs, weekday programs, training, events and meetings
